Passes Away Following Influenza at Ferney Home

Mrs. Robert Mielke passed away at her home near Ferney on Tuesday night. Cause of death was pneumonia following an attack of influenza.

Funeral services were held today, Rev. Burmeister, pastor of the Lutheran church officiating with interment in Ferney cemetery. Music furnished by the Garden Prairie choir.

At the time of death Mrs. Mielke was twenty-six years of age and was a native of the community. She had been born in the house in which she died, the place having been formerly occupied by Frank Dobberpuhl and his family.

She lived in the community from her birth and eight years ago was united in marriage to Robert Mielke. To them two children were born, Evelyn and Dorothy, aged respectively seven and three years. She was survived by her husband and a number of relatives who mourn her loss.

Among those who were here today for the funeral were Mr. Mielke, of Fargo, N. D., Mrs. Mittag, of Hankinson, N. D., the parents of Mrs. Mielke, Mr. Frank Dobberpuhl, who now resides in Wisconsin.
