Services for Bernhardt W. (Pee Wee) Miller, 25, were held at 2 p. m., Tuesday, Nov. 21, at St. John Lutheran Church in Groton. He was killed in Vietnam on November 10.

The Rev. Gordon Buchholz officiated and burial was in the Military Circle at the Groton Cemetery with the Groton American Legion Post No. 39 conducting the military rites. Ackerson Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.
