## Glenn E. Miller

Funeral services for Glenn E. Miller, 78, were held Thursday, April 5, at 10:30 a.m. at Emmanuel Lutheran Church with the Rev. Jon Simundson officiating. Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery.

Mr. Miller passed away Monday, April 2, at Dakota Midland Hospital in Aberdeen.
