## MRS. HELEN MILLER'S FUNERAL HELD TUESDAY

The funeral of Mrs. Helen Miller, an early resident of this city and community, who died at the home of her daughter in Creswell, Ore., last Friday, was held from the Paetznick funeral home Tuesday morning, and the remains laid to rest in Groton cemetery. The services were conducted by Rev. L. C. Benson.

Mrs. Miller was born June 3, 1853, at Sheboygan, Wis., where she spent her early childhood. Later she moved to Chilton, Wis., where she met and married George F. Miller on November 24, 1875. Two children were born to this union, Olive Miller Parlin, of Creswell, Ore., and Carrie Miller, who died at the age of 23 on February 23, 1903, at Groton. Her husband passed away in March, 1893.

In the early eighties the Millers came to Brown county and settled upon a farm southwest of Groton. Shortly after the death of her husband, Mrs. Miller took a position as teacher in the city schools of Groton and later became identified with the Miller Mercantile company. She was with this concern until 1918 when ill health forced her to retire and she went west for her health, finally settling at Heron, Mont., with her daughter. She lived at Heron until two years ago when they moved to Creswell, Ore.
