Myrtle Hazel Moe, 87, of Aberdeen died Friday, May 30, 2003 at the Aberdeen Living Center. Her funeral will be 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 3rd at Scandinavia Lutheran Church, rural Bath, SD with Rev. Keith O. Hanson officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery.

Visitation will be 3-8 p.m., Monday and 9 a.m.-12:00 noon, Tuesday at Miller-Huebl Funeral Home, 1111 South Main St., Aberdeen and one hour prior to the service at the church.

Myrtle Hazel Von Wald was born July 18, 1915 in West Hanson Township, Brown County near James, South Dakota. The family moved to Stratford in 1916 where she attended school. She married Sigurd Moe on June

1, 1956 at Stratford where they moved to Sigurd's farm southeast of Bath where they farmed. Sigurd died in January of 1996 and Myrtle remained on the farm until she became a resident of the Aberdeen Living Center in March of 2003.

She was baptized at the West Hanson Church and was confirmed in the Lutheran faith at the St. Paul's Lutheran Church at Stratford. She was a member of Scandinavia Lutheran Church, where she taught Sunday school for several years, served as the church secretary from 1963 to 2003 and served on the church council for six years. She was also a member of the Golden Pheasant Extension Club. Myrtle was a very good friend to the community.

Myrtle and Sigurd liked to travel and had visited every state. They made annual trips to Wisconsin and Minnesota and took several bus and car tours to Washington, D.C., Niagara Falls, the Rose Bowl Parade, New Orleans, the Tulip Festival in Iowa, the Black Hills of South Dakota, Minneapolis, New York, Chicago, and Canada.

Survivors include sister-in-laws and cousins. She was preceded in death by her parents, husband, and two brothers, Alvin and Milton.
