Richard "Dick" Morris, 64, Britton, died Friday, Dec. 29, 2006 at Avera St. Luke's Hospital, Aberdeen.

His memorial service was Tuesday, Jan. 2, 2007 at the United Methodist Church, Britton, with the Rev. Terrill Sorenson officiating. Arrangements were made by Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton.

Richard C. Morris was born April 14, 1942 in Britton to Claude L. and Della E. (Satterlee) Morris. He graduated from high school in 1960 and continued his education at Northern State College, Aberdeen. Dick enlisted in the US Air Force and after his discharge, he worked with his uncle as a bricklayer. He later enrolled in Barber College in Bettendorf, Iowa, and worked for a short time as a barber in Mason City. Dick returned home to Britton and purchased the barber shop from Randy Eikamp, renaming the business Dick's Barber Shop. He has operated the business for the past 32 years.
