Mrs. Mary E. Nehls, 80, Groton, died at Colonial Manor, Groton, Tuesday, June 22, 1993.

Her funeral was held at the First Presbyterian Church, Groton, Friday, June 25, 1993, with the Rev. Richard Geiger officiating. Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery, with the Paetznick-Garress Funeral Chapel, Groton in charge of arrangements.
