BOY KICKED BY A HORSE; DIES LATER

FIVE-YEAR-OLD SON OF MR.
AND MRS. OLAF LARSON
DIES IN ABERDEEN ✓

Clinton Olaf, the five-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Olaf Larson, living north of James, died in an Aberdeen hospital last week from the effects of being kicked in the face by a horse last Tuesday.

The little fellow went into the pasture with his elder brother to round up some stock and the lad approached too close to the horse. The animal let fly and one of his hoofs struck the little fellow squarely over the left eye, smashing in his forehead. He was taken to an Aberdeen hospital, where medical attention was given, but the wound was too serious and he died from its effects on Friday.

H. Paetznick, undertaker of Groton, went to Aberdeen after the body and the funeral was held on Tuesday and burial made in the Swedish cemetery northeast of Groton. Rev. Lindstrom conducted the services.
