
DEATH CLAIMS AARON OLSON

WIDELY KNOWN GROTON FARM-
ER DIES AT HOME OF
DAUGHTER, TUESDAY

Aaron A. Olson, since 1904 a prosperous and progressive farmer of Groton, died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Bert Lee, Tuesday night. He had been ill with a complication of diseases for some time preceding his death.

At the time of his death he was 68 years of age. He was born April 5, 1860, in Decorah, Iowa, was married to Martha Langland in that city on May 3, 1883. In 1904 they moved to Groton, settling on the farm just north of the city, where he lived until five years ago. Since then he has made his home with his daughter, Mrs. Bert Lee, in Groton.

Six children were born, four of whom still survive. They are Mrs. K. Holum, Mrs. Herman Julson, Mrs. Bert Lee and Alfred Olson, all of Groton.

Mr. Olson was a member of the Lutheran church of Groton, and an active worker in church affairs.
