Funeral services were held for Mrs. Daniel (Jackqueline) Olson, 20, of Claremont, at St. John's Lutheran Church in Hecla, Friday morning, July 5. The Rev. Charles Peterson of the Claremont Augustana Lutheran Church officiated.
