Lillian K. Olson, 84, Groton, formerly Yankton, died at the Colonial Manor Nursing Home, Groton, Sunday, Oct. 11, 1987.

Her funeral was held Wednesday, Oct. 14 at 2 p.m. at Christ Episcopal Church, Yankton with the Rev. Frederick D. Dougherty officiating. Burial was in the Yankton Cemetery under the direction of Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton and the Ray Funeral Home, Yankton.
