Edward William Reinhardt

Funeral services were held Monday at 2:00 p. m., for Edward Reinhardt, at St. John's Lutheran church, with the Rev. R. M. Grundmeier officiating. Burial was in the family lot in the Groton cemetery. Mr. Reinhardt passed away last Monday, July 6, 1953, suddenly from a heart attack, at the home of his daughter in Portland, Ore.

Pall bearers were Geo. Berg, Oscar Thiemann, Ross Funk, Vance E. Miller, A. J. Schuelke and G. W. Potter.

Mr. Reinhardt was born Sept. 30, 1879, in Webster City, Iowa. He was baptized and confirmed in St. Paul's Lutheran church, Webster City. On June 18, 1902, he was united in marriage to Rae Susan Fank. To this union four children were born. His wife, parents, five brothers and a son preceded him in death.

The Reinhardt family were engaged in farming in the state of Iowa before moving to a farm in the Groton vicinity in 1920. Retiring in 1940 they purchased a home in Groton, where they resided until the death of Mrs. Reinhardt, eight years ago. Most of the time since he has made his home with his children.

The deceased's genial disposition and kindness won him the friendship of a large circle of friends, who extend sincere sympathy to the family in the loss of their loved one.
