Services for Henry E. Reinhardt, 93, former Brown County Commissioner, were held Wednesday, July 18, at St. John's Lutheran Church in Groton with the Rev. Monte Gusewelle officiating.

Mr. Reinhardt died Saturday, July 15, at Stillwater, Minn., where he had been residing.

David Sueltz was the soloist and Mrs. Eugene Neuman was the organist.

Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery. The Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel was in charge of arrangements.

Casket bearers were Leslie Dohman, Francis Dohman, Maurice Harry, James Hoops, Kenneth Schaller and John Schinkel.

Mr. Reinhardt was born September 2, 1885, at Ferney. He lived in the Groton-Ferney area most of his life. He married Theresa Semm July 5, 1919, at Webster. He farmed and was in the road construction business. He served as a Brown County commissioner from 1937 to 1964. In 1969 he moved to Stillwater, Minn. For the past three years he had resided at the Greeley Nursing Home in Stillwater.

Survivors include one son, Raymond, of Stillwater; one daughter, Mrs. Carrol (Lois) Bingham of Saratoga, Calif.; seven grandchildren and 11 great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife, one daughter and one sister.
