Mrs. Roy Rix

Relatives and friends were saddened, Thursday morning, when they learned that Mrs. Roy Rix had passed away Wednesday, April 23, at the Britton hospital, where she had been a patient since Monday. She was 75 years of age at the time of her death.

Funeral services were held at the local Presbyterian church at 3:00 p. m., on Saturday, with the Reverends George Clark and F. G. MacKenzie officiating. Songs were rendered by a quartet composed of Mrs. Palmer G. Peterson, Mrs. Clayton Gibbs, Gilbert Erdmann and Richard Mylin. Mrs. Mylin presided at the organ. Pall bearers were all nephews of Mr. Rix: Foster, Floyd, Wilbur, Art, Otho and Arden Rix. Burial was in the Groton cemetery.

Delia Jerman was born in Warren, Pa., Feb. 3, 1877. She came to Groton in 1903 and on Oct. 19, 1905, was united in marriage to Roy W. Rix at the home of her uncle and aunt, Mr. and Mrs. W. H. Preston. To this union three children were born, two of whom died in infancy. Mrs. Rix was a member of the Groton Trinity Episcopal church and was truly a christian woman, a devoted wife, mother and grandmother. She was ever ready to care for the sick and to assist those in need. Even when death was near, she was concerned about the health and welfare of others. She was also a member of the Rebekah and Royal Neighbor lodges and the Past Noble Grand club.

Besides her husband she leaves to mourn her passing her son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Luther Gullickson and two grand-daughters, Gail and Barbara of Claremont; three brothers, Stephen and George Jerman of Warren, Pa. and William Jerman of Cleveland, Ohio. Other survivors are a niece, Mrs. Ivan Zoellner, and a cousin, W. R. Preston of Groton, besides a host of relatives here and in Pennsylvania.
