

## Floyd A. Rix, 95

The funeral for Floyd A. Rix, 95, Groton, was held Saturday morning, Dec. 21, at the United Methodist Church, Groton, with the Rev. Dean Trapp officiating.

Burial was at Groton Union Cemetery, with Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton, in charge of arrangements. Military graveside rites were conducted by the Groton American Legion.

Mr. Rix died Wednesday, Dec. 18, 1991 at Colonial Manor nursing home, Groton.

Floyd A. Rix was born March 14, 1896, to William and Julia (Stelter) Rix, Groton. He farmed in the Groton area all his life. He served in World War I. He married Lillian Walter in Groton, October 13, 1922.

He was a member of Groton United Methodist Church; Groton American Legion; Aberdeen Elks and served on the Riverside Township School Board in the 1930's and 1940's.
