Arnold O. Rose, 76, Hettinger, N.D., died Friday, Jan. 5, 1990, at the West River Regional Medical Center from a heart attack.

The funeral was held at Redeemer Evangelical Lutheran Church at Hettinger, January 9, 1990. The Rev. Timothy Johnston officiated. He was buried in the Hettinger Cemetery.

He was born February 8, 1913 to Robert and Barbara (Von Wold) Rose at Groton. He was baptized in the Lutheran Church in Groton and confirmed in the Zion Lutheran Church, Reeder, N.D.
