Services for Mrs. Geo. (Pansy) Rosenberg, 72, former Aberdeen and Groton resident were held at 2:00 p. m., Tuesday, July 8, at the Huebl Funeral Chapel in Aberdeen.

Dr. Harold W. Wagar officiated and burial was in Riverside Cemetery.

Mrs. Rosenberg died Friday at the Arlington Nursing Home at Arlington, where she had resided since leaving Aberdeen in March.

The former Pansy M. Swearingen was born May 21, 1897, at Walnut Grove, Ill., and was 9 when her family moved to the Groton area. She was married at Buda, Ill., and she and her husband lived at Buda a short time before moving to Groton.

After the death of her husband, Mrs. Rosenberg lived at Aberdeen and at Fairfield, Calif., with a son, Ronald, returning to Aberdeen in May, 1968. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church and Women of the Moose.

In addition to the son, she is survived by two brothers, Joseph Swearingen, Groton and Harry Swearingen, Aberdeen; two sisters, Mrs. Martin (Mary) Engelson, Lakeland, Fla., and Mrs. Isabel Zeller, Aberdeen and three grandchildren.
