## Ralph S. Roy

Ralph S. Roy, 1187 Ohio Ave. SW, retired Huron High School science teacher, died early Saturday morning at St. John's Hospital in Huron of an apparent heart attack. He was 77.

The services were held Monday, Feb. 2, at 2:00 p. m., in the First United Methodist church with the Rev. Robert P. Nielsen officiating. Burial was in Restlawn Memory Garden. Masonic and Eastern Star rites were conducted.

Roy was born May 5, 1892, to Mr. and Mrs. James Roy at Lisbon, N. D. As a child he moved to St. Hilaire, Minn. He was graduated from the Grand Forks University High School and received both his bachelor's and master's degrees from the University of North Dakota, Grand Forks. He was married June 6, 1923 to Mabel Blader at Groton. He taught three years at Groton before moving to Huron. He taught science at HHS for 33 years, retiring in 1957.

He was a member of the First United Methodist Church, past patron of Mizpah Chapter No. 9, Order of Eastern Star and a master Mason.

Survivors include his widow, Mabel; three brothers, Theodore, Long Beach, Calif.; Edwin and Paul, Thief River Falls, Minn.
