Funeral services for Armund T. Schley, 78, Stratford, were held Wednesday, Jan. 6 at 2 p.m. at St. Paul's Lutheran Church of Stratford. Rev. Melbourne Helling officiated and burial was in the East Rondell Cemetery.

Mr. Schley died Friday, Jan. 1 at Dakota Midland Hospital.
