FRED SCHMIDT, PIONEER, EXPIRES

**FUNERAL WILL BE HELD SATUR-
DAY AT FERNEY; BURIAL
THERE**

Fred Schmidt, another one of the early pioneers of Brown county, died in an Aberdeen hospital, Tuesday. His death, primarily, was caused by old age, although he had been in failing health for the past three years.

Mr. Schmidt was born in Germany, April 23, 1864, and came to this country and settled near Ferney in 1882. He was married in 1880, and was the father of ten children, all of whom are living. The funeral will be held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Ferney Lutheran church, with Rev. Dommer officiating. Interment will be made in the cemetery at that place.
