Emma Olga Schroeder, daughter of August and Augusta Sauer, was born October 28, 1890, at Webster. She was baptized December 26, 1890, and on April 2, 1905, she was confirmed in the Lutheran faith in St. Paul's Lutheran Church at Webster. On April 29, 1922, she was united in marriage to August Schroeder of Andover, where they made their home until her husband's death; then she moved to Groton, where she resided until her death on May 18, 1958, at the age of 67 years, 6 months, and 20 days, at her home here.

Mrs. Schroeder was preceded in death by her husband, parents, two sisters, Anna and Ida, and one brother, Christian, who died in infancy. No children were born to this union.

She leaves to mourn her death two sisters, Mrs. Fred Harms and Mrs. Herman Bahr, both of Groton, and three brothers, Emil, Henry and Frederick Sauer, all of Webster.

Funeral services were held May 21, at the St. John's Lutheran Church in Groton with the Rev. R. M. Grundmeier officiating. Two songs were sung by Ora Schuelke, with Mrs. Eugene Neuman, as organist.

Pallbearers were Anert Widvey, Ervin Emmens, Richard Voss, Robert Hein, Ivan Morehouse and Arthur Raap.

Burial was in the Andover cemetery, beside the remains of her husband, who passed away Nov. 7, 1951.
