Edith Shoemaker

Final rites were observed Wednesday, April 7, for Miss Edith Shoemaker, 75, who died at St. Anthony Hospital in Carroll, Iowa, Saturday, April 3rd.

Services were at the Huffman Funeral Home in Glidden, Iowa, with the Rev. E. Raymond Heglin officiating. Mrs. Clark MacDonald was organist. Casket bearers were Dave Moorhouse, Garner McNaught, Fred Rudi, Bill Moorhouse, Carl Clausen and Dor Haggard. Interment was in Westlawr Cemetery in Glidden.

Miss Shoemaker was born August 20, 1889, at Elign, Neb., a daughter of Harry P. and Martha Bellinger Shoemaker. A registered nurse, she served in the United States Army from 1918 until 1945, when she retired. She had been a resident of Glidden since 1957. She was a member of the Presbyterian Church and of the PEO Sisterhood at Groton.

Surviving are a brother, R. D. Shoemaker of Glidden and several nieces including Mrs. Delbert Clawson of Groton, and also nephews. One brother and three sisters preceded her in death.
