Margaret E. Sieh, 97, Groton, died at Mother Joseph Manor, Aberdeen, March 23, 1991.

The funeral was held at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church, March 26, 1991, with the Rev. Odo Gogel, chaplain at Mother Joseph Manor, officiating. Burial was in the Groton Catholic Cemetery under the direction of Paetznick-Garner Funeral Chapel, Groton. There was a scriptural wake service Monday evening at the funeral chapel with Deacon Harold Pardew officiating.

Margaret Wallace was born May 13, 1893, in Aberdeen to William and Cora Simpson Wallace. She grew up in Aberdeen and graduated from Aberdeen Central. She attended Northern Normal and Industrial School in Aberdeen. She married Charles A. Sieh at Aberdeen June 12, 1914. They farmed near James. Charles died in 1949 and Mrs. Sieh moved to Groton in 1957 where she resided until moving to Mother Joseph Manor in 1977.
