Unexpected death of 12 year old Marcia Sippel, early Saturday morning at Luke's Hospital, stunned the community with shock and sorrow.

She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Henry Sippel of Putney. She became ill Thursday evening, was taken to hospital the following evening and died Saturday morning of spinal meningitis. Marcie, as she was affectionately called, was a 6th grader in the Putney School. She was born on Feb. 11, 1955 and lived all her 12 years in Putney. She was a member of the Methodist Church.

Funeral services were held Monday, Feb. 20, at 2:00 p. m., in the local Methodist church with the Rev. K. O. Erickson officiating. Interment was at Memorial Gardens, Aberdeen. Representatives of her class in school attended in a body.
