## Mrs. Julia L. Smith

Julia Lena Hargrow was born at Graton Center, Mich., April 4, 1868. She came to Groton when a young girl of 18 years and later followed the dress-making trade.

She was married to Arthur H. Smith, a native of Erie, Penn., on December 31, 1896, and they resided at Columbia, S. D., where Mr. Smith was in the banking business. Mr. Smith preceded her in death on Jan. 31, 1943.

The past four years Mrs. Smith resided with her brother in Los Angeles, Calif., where she passed away on Saturday, Feb. 18, from the effects of a stroke at the age of 80 years.

She is survived by one sister, Mrs. Martin Cavanaugh of Aberdeen, and four brothers, William of Los Angeles, Calif.; George I., of Groton, S. D.; Charles E., of Fairmont Minn., and Stephen of Winner, S. D. Also several nieces and nephews.
