## Edwin Solberg

Services for Edwin A. Solberg, 78, of 912 South Lawson Street, Aberdeen, were held at 10 a.m. Tuesday, Sept. 18, at Scandinavia Lutheran Church with the Rev. David Rasmussen officiating.

Burial was in the church cemetery.

Mr. Solberg died at his home Friday, Sept. 14.

Edwin A. Solberg was born May 23, 1895, in Gem Township. He farmed in that area and married Emma Noble. They had two children. Mrs. Solberg later died and in 1927 he married Andrea Gunnerson at Veblen.

They farmed and operated a grocery store in Stratford and in 1947 moved to Aberdeen where he operated a grocery store in the Morning Heights area. Mr. Solberg retired in 1965 and his wife died in 1972.

He was a member of Scandinavia Church and the World War I Barracks in Aberdeen.

Survivors are one son, Wesley of Ashford, Wash.; one daughter, Mrs. Elmer (Alvina) Stauffer, Polo, Ill.; one brother, Perry Solberg, Aberdeen; one sister, Mrs. Ed Ringsaker, Lidgerwood, N.D.; five grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren.

Preceding him in death, in addition to his wives, were two children from the second marriage, four brothers and two sisters.
