MRS. GOTTLIEB STELTER

Another of the tried and true pioneers responded to the last call when Mrs. Gottlieb Stelter was summoned to the great beyond on Sunday, March 1.

Augusta Henrietta Stelter was born in 1858, and would have been fifty years of age on the 3rd of July next.

She became the wife of Gottlieb Stelter in 1880 at Dodge Center, Minn. and to them twelve children were born—ten girls and two boys. About ten years ago triplets were born to them, one of whom died some time after birth. Eleven children and the husband survive her.

Funeral services were held yesterday afternoon at the Evangelical church, conducted by Rev. C. F. Strutz.
