Services for John Joseph Wattier, 70, of Wilmot were held at 2:00 p. m. Sunday, Aug. 18th, at the Emanuel Funeral Home, Milbank, with the Rev. Fred Eberbach officiating. Burial was at 5:00 p. m., at the Groton cemetery.

Mr. Wattier passed away Thursday. Death was attributed to a heart attack.

He was born May 30, 1893 at Bristol. He attended school in Bristol and moved to Leola as a young man. He later resided in Groton where he operated a meat market in partnership with his late brother, Alphonse, from 1921 to 1929, and near James, where he farmed. Then he operated a cafe in Andover moving to Wilmot in 1947.

Mr. Wattier married Anna Krause at Aberdeen, who preceded him in death.

Survivors include a daughter, Mrs. Lawrence DeJong (Margaret Ann), Milbank; four sisters, one brother, a half sister and a half brother and six grandchildren.
