Funeral services for Mrs. Harvey (Darla) Wheatley, 46, 1131 3rd St. NE, Watertown, were held at 2 p.m. Monday in the Mount Olive Lutheran Church. The Rev. Roger C. Fisher officiated. Mrs. Wheatley died from cancer May 2 in a Watertown hospital.

Burial was in the Mount Hope Cemetery.

Mrs. Wheatley was born September 5, 1938, at Clark to Mr. and Mrs. Ora Stevens. She graduated from Clark High School in 1956 and was employed in the office at Memorial Medical Center for five years. She married Harvey Wheatley December 3, 1960, at Watertown.

The couple made their homes at Ortonville, Minn., where she was employed in the Northwestern Bank, and Groton before moving to Watertown about 1975. She was employed at the Red Owl Country Store Greenhouse at Watertown in 1981-82-83, managing the business in 1982 and 1983.

She was a member of the Mount Olive Lutheran Women's Missionary League and Sunshine Committee, Watertown Garden Club, a domestic violence volunteer for the Women's Resource Center, and was a Reach for Recovery Chairman for the American Cancer Society in Codington County.

She delivered Meals on Wheels and was involved in volunteer work for the March of Dimes and the American Heart Association.

While undergoing cancer treatment at Sioux Falls, she was a volunteer for the Evangelical Lutheran Good Samaritan Society.

She is survived by her husband; two daughters, Mrs. Wayne (Lori) Mohr of Baltic and Viki Wheatley of Watertown; her parents of Henry; a sister, Mrs. Bill (Peggy) Cordell of Solomon, Kan.; and a brother, Larry Stevens of Bryant.
