**Mrs. Lois J. Wismer  
Passes Away Saturday**

Mrs. Lois J. Wismer, wife of D. E. Wismer, of Groton, died at her home here Saturday night, following a long period of ill health. She has been rather feeble for the past three or four years, but it was not until recently that her condition became serious.

The deceased was a Canadian by birth, having been born at Port Burrell, Ontario, a seaport on Lake Erie. She and her husband came to the United States in 1887 and lived on a farm west of Groton for a great many years. They moved to Minneapolis where they resided about 25 years, before returning to Groton, where they have since resided. She is survived by her husband and one daughter, Mrs. Mabel Veitch. A daughter, Matie, preceded her in death a number of years ago. One brother R. B. McCleish, of Edmonton, Alberta, Canada, also survives to mourn her loss.

The funeral was held from the home on Tuesday afternoon, conducted by Rev. Luther C. Benson, pastor of the Methodist church, and the remains were laid to rest in Groton cemetery.
