Otto Wockenfuss

On Sunday, May 22, 1955, Otto Wockenfuss passed away at his Mille Lacs, Minn., home, following a heart attack. Services were held at Isle, Minn., Friday, with burial at Mille Lacs.

The deceased, son of Mr. and Mrs. Ferdinand Wockenfuss was born at Groton and made his home here for some time before leaving here many years ago.

His two sons, Major Wilbur and Lt. Alan Wockenfuss, arrived from Japan about an hour before the services. They had been grounded in the Hawaiian Islands for two days.

Mr. Wockenfuss leaves besides his two sons, his wife, Lenora; a daughter, Mrs. Lambert Wattier of Webster and several grand children; also one sister, Mrs. Lydia Gustafson of Claremont; three brothers, Edward of Pine River, Minn., William of Ixonia, Wis., and Ben of Ipswich. All were present at the services.
