Stanley C. Young

Stanley C. Young, 66, former Groton banker, died in a Mesa, Ariz., hospital Saturday, Jan. 13, after an extended illness.

Funeral services were at 2 p.m. today at the Meldrum Mortuary Chapel in Mesa, with burial in Mesa.

Mr. Young was born July 28, 1906, in Centuria, Wis., and moved to Groton in 1923. While in Groton he was employed at the First National Bank. He moved to Aberdeen in January 1925 and lived there until his retirement in 1969 when he moved to Mesa. He had been in the banking business since 1925 and at the time of retirement, Mr. Young was a vice-president of the First National Bank of Aberdeen. He was married to Erma Persinger November 10, 1930, in Aberdeen.

Mr. Young was in the U.S. Army from 1942 to 1945, was a member of the Methodist Church, the Elks Lodge and the American Legion in Aberdeen. He served as treasurer of the Groton County Republican Central Committee.

Survivors include his widow at Madrid Plaza, Mesa; one son, Stanley Young, Mesa; one daughter Jean, both in Mesa; his mother, Mrs. Mabel Youngquist, San Carlos, Calif.; two daughters, Lauren Youngquist of Berkeley Hills, Calif., and Marvin Youngquist of San Francisco, Calif.; two sisters, Mrs. C.A. (Vera) Young, San Carlos, Calif., and Mrs. George (Carol) Trench of Appleton, Calif.
