MRS. CARL ZIESMAN DIES FROM DROPSY

**FUNERAL HELD MONDAY AND
REMAINS LAID TO REST IN
GROTON CEMETERY**

Mrs. Paulina (Carl) Ziesman, a highly respected lady of this city, died at her home last Thursday from the effects of dropsy after having been ill for the past five months. The funeral was held from St. John's Lutheran church Monday afternoon at 2:00 o'clock and the remains were laid to rest in Groton cemetery. The funeral services were conducted by Rev. F. E. Wilke, pastor of the church. Mrs. Ziesman was a life-long member of that faith.

The deceased was born in Prussia, Germany, Jan. 20, 1861. She was married June 8, 1883, and together with her husband, came to this country in 1889, settling near Groton. Since that time both she and her husband, who passed away some time ago, were respected residents of this community, rearing a large family and going about their every day activities unobtrusively and quietly.

Ten children were born to Mr. and Mrs. Ziesman, but four of them have passed away. The six remaining are, Mrs. A. B. Bechard, Hugo, Mrs. W. F. Bruce and Herman, of Draper; Emil Ziesman of Okobojo, and Mrs. Herman Pigors of Groton. There are also 23 grandchildren and 11 great grandchildren.
