Robert T. (Pete) Zimney, 64, Groton, died at St. Luke's Midland Regional Medical Center, December 25, 1991.

Funeral services were held at the First Presbyterian Church, Groton, Saturday Dec. 28, 1991 with Rev. Richard Geiger officiating. Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery. There were Military Graveside Rites by the Groton American Legion Post #39.

Robert Zimney was born April 26, 1927 in Andover to Peter and Mildred (Gooding) Zimney. He attended Groton School and in 1945 joined the U.S. Navy. After his discharge he returned to Groton and married Doris Craig in Aberdeen, June 26, 1948. They made their home in Groton and he worked for the Ford Garage. The family moved to Spokane, Wash. in 1962 where he worked for a Lincoln-mercury dealership. In 1963 they returned to Groton and he worked for Trail Chevrolet and Olds. He managed Green Gro Inc. fertilizer plant for several years before working for Valley Farmers Elevator. In 1981 he suffered a disabling stroke and was forced to retire. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church, Groton and also served as a trustee. He was a member of the Groton American Legion Post #39.
